



COMPOUNDED MELOXICAM

Introducing Two New Compounded Products

Meloxicam is classified as a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID). It is a prescription strength painkiller and only available through veterinarians. In Europe and Canada, where it has been used in pigs for over 20 years, it is labeled for the treatment of lameness, MMA (mastitis-metritis-agalactia), and for the relief of post-operative pain associated with minor soft tissue surgery such as castration and tail docking. Meloxicam is not an antibiotic, and in cases of infectious arthritis or septicemia with MMA, appropriate antibiotic therapy should be used concurrently.

Meloxicam Soluble is miscible with Lincomycin and Amoxicillin Red in the same stock solution. If other antibiotics are desired, tandem water medicators are an option to consider, or the use of injectables or feed medications.

0.6% (6 MG/ML) **MELOXICAM SOLUBLE**

Dosage rate of 1 pint/5 gallons of stock solution to be medicated at 1:128 for 5-7 days. This concentration should deliver 0.1 mg/kg.



1.5% (15 MG/ML) **MELOXICAM SUSPENSION DRENCH**

Available in either liter bottles or 1 gallon jugs.

Dosage rate of 1 ml/83 lbs to be used as a one-time drench to deliver 0.4mg/kg (sows) or 1 ml/66 lbs to deliver 0.5 mg/kg (calves).
